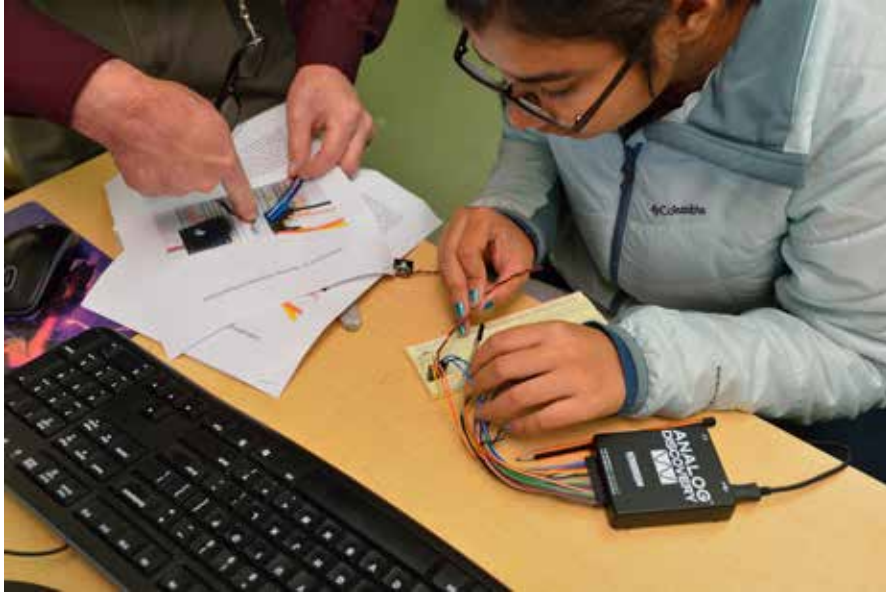


Electrical Engineering Lab Day



Wednesday July 1st 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

The University of Mississippi's School of Engineering would like to invite high school students who are rising juniors and seniors to an Electrical Engineering Lab Day.

EE Lab Day will introduce students to the real world of electrical engineering work and study with a morning session and an afternoon session. Students will perform lab-based experiments and see practical demonstrations, and they'll hear about the broad range of career opportunities available to electrical engineers.

The day will comprise a morning session and an afternoon session, with lunch at The Grill 1810. Students will spend the morning doing basic electronic experiments and then working on biomedical/electrical measurements. After lunch, they'll see a demonstration of the athletics department's new concussion measurement system. Finally, the students will do computer-engineering experiments using Arduino boards.
